As part of our commitment to ethical business practice Harris Wood Machining can assure customers and shareholders that the hardwood products we sell are derived from a sustainable and certified source.

As part of our implementation and maintenance of the Chain of Custody system Harris Wood Machining will:

- Ensure no logs we process are sourced from illegal operations
- Have a system that supports the authenticity of the origin of hardwood products
- Maintain a documentation system that allows traceability, tracking and recording throughout the supply chain
- Comply with all relevant legislation, regulations and codes of practice
- Act fairly and honestly with our employees, suppliers and regulatory agencies
- Develop the necessary skills of our employees, and
- Conduct regular systems audits and correct any non-conformity.

Harris Wood Machining will continue to look for ways to improve our environmental, social and economic performance and continuously improve our Chain of Custody system and procedures.
